The Zac Brown Band is from Atlanta, GA, and has had several #1 hits on the Billboard Country Charts including such songs as "Chicken Fried" and "Colder Weather".

<u>Kelly McGuire</u> is from Clear Lake, TX, and his album "Boat in Belize" was voted the Album of the Year by the Texas Music Awards in 2008.

This <u>Brent Burns</u> song is from his 1999 album *Livin' the Life*. Burns is an icon of the Gulf Shores, AL, area and has made the Top 100 Billboard charts several times with songs like "Cheaper Crude or No More Food".

<u>Jimmy Buffett</u> is the undisputed king of Gulf and Western music and pioneered the Key West sound. This song is from his *Beach House on the Moon* album, which reached #8 on the Billboard Country Charts in 1999.

<u>Don Middlebrook and Living Soul</u> began their music career by going up and down the west Michigan coastline. They have recorded 8 albums since their 1991 debut.

"If I Had a Boat" is from <u>Lyle Lovett's</u> second album. Lyle, who needs no introduction, recalls trying to ride a pony across a pond, but preferring a boat - supposedly this is a true story, but this can only be confirmed or denied by Lyle himself.

<u>Jim Morris's</u> song is from his first album. This Georgia native has been called the perfect cross between Jimmy Buffett and Jerry Jeff Walker.

<u>James "Sunny Jim" White</u> is a native Texan, growing up in Corpus Christi and then San Fransisco. He is a regular on Jimmy Buffett's Radio Margaritaville program.

Mark Mulligan is an island rocker from Arizona who now makes his home as an ex-pat in Mexico. He enjoys playing music, his kids, and the simple life.

Tommy Alverson is the pride of Itasca football and the "godfather of Metroplex Honky-Tonks".

<u>Howard Livingston and the Mile Marker 24 Band</u> are known as "the Portable Party Machine", hailing from the Florida Keys area.
